We are in receipt of your letter dated April 22 inviting us to send a representative to an introductory meeting on May 11th with the purpose of forming a Community Advisory Panel. Thank you for your invitation and for the initiative you have taken in this regard.

As a part of its mandate, Grandview Woodland Area Council supports and co-operates with neighbourhood groups and initiatives committed to the improvement of air quality. Accordingly, we have met with the ad hoc community group (Don Dickson, Sheila Craigie, Brenda Belak, and Blair Redlin) which has been active regarding the ruling by the Environmental Appeal Board rejecting both Metro Vancouver's 2008 Permit and an appeal by the ad hoc group.

While we appreciate your move toward establishing the advisory panel, we want you to know that we are firmly in support of the neighbourhood group. In line with their request, we would re-iterate the conditions they feel are contingent to participation in the panel. To wit:

- (1) Participation in this panel should be contingent on West Coast Reduction agreeing that it is the source of egregious and offensive odours which cause harm to residents of this neighborhood every summer;
- (2) West Coast Reduction needs to confirm that it is going to stop these odours;
- (3) The sole work and purpose of the panel should be to help implement a plan to stop the odours right away.

Again, we thank you for the invitation to participate in this panel, and we look forward to further communication in the near future.
